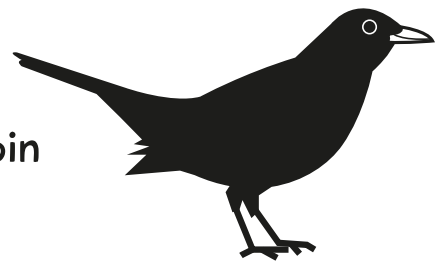

Birds get hungry in the winter! Make a bird feeder for your back garden! You need:

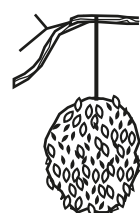
- Pine Cones • String • Bird Seed • Suet / Lard • Raisins
